Foodbank expands!

Loughton Foodbank has an announcement to make: it is opening a new Distribution Centre in Epping, and changing name to **Epping Forest Foodbank!**

Over the past four years, Loughton Foodbank has provided an incredible 20,000 meals to those individuals referred in the Epping Forest area. Of these, nearly 50% went to people from within the seven Loughton wards. But what about those living outside?

Loughton Foodbank has become increasingly aware that some referred within Epping Forest are unable to redeem their vouchers- simply because they haven't the means to travel to one of the Loughton based Distribution Centres or receive an Emergency Food Box directly from a care professional.

To meet the need, Epping Forest Foodbank has partnered with Churches together in Epping & District (CTED) and 'The Box' on St John's Road, Epping.

The Epping Distribution Foodbank centre will open on Monday 8th May, and run from 3:30pm-5pm every Monday thereafter (although it will be closed on bank holidays).

This will provide another option for clients living beyond Loughton to redeem their vouchers and obtain their emergency food parcel.

F.I.S.H. Club a great success!

There are approximately 170 non-school days a year where children receiving Free School Meals (FSM) cannot access this food. Having children at home means having to find more food, childcare and ways to entertain children, all of which costs money. This puts pressure on household budgets making it even harder to ensure that children and families are eating well.

F.I.S.H. (Food in School Holidays) is a project which aims to help families who struggle to cope with these financial demands: providing food, fun activities and support to families that find the holidays difficult.

It was successfully piloted last summer in collaboration with True Stars Children's Centre and Epping Forest District Council's Health and Well-being Team, then over Christmas 2016. We were delighted to use the Limes Centre facility to hold it again over Easter, where 9 families benefited from the fun and provision, with nearly 40 hot and nutritious meals served

up.

One child told us excitedly: "I made lots of toys and crafts for Easter and the volunteers were always there to listen and chat - they were lovely!"

A participating Mum thanked us: "I enjoyed doing different activities with my girls- they absolutely loved it and looked forward to coming. Please keep on providing the service, it's amazing!"

We are looking to expand the project so that we can run more F.I.S.H. events across the District in alongside local organisations. We welcome volunteers, so please get in touch if interested!
